Herbert M. Sachs was appointed Special Projects Coordinator in the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) in 1998. In this capacity, Mr. Sachs is serving as Senior Staff to the Governor's Advisory Committee on the Management and Protection of the State's Water Resources; Maryland Alternate Commissioner to the Susquehanna River Basin Commission; MDE representative on the Patuxent River Commission, State Soil Conservation and State Envirothon Executive Committees, and liaison to Coastal Bays Restoration Program; MDE lead for water supply/demand study of Potomac River Basin; and MDE liaison to Anne Arundel County in the investigation of radium contaminated groundwater.

Mr. Sachs has served the citizens of Maryland in various capacities since 1962, including being the Executive Director of the Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin and holding numerous key positions at MDE including Assistant Secretary and Director of Water Resources Administration. Prior to his work at MDE, Mr. Sachs also served as Chief of Planning of Planning in the Maryland Department of Water Resource.

Mr. Sachs received his B.A. (1955) in Government and Politics from the University of Maryland and a M.S. (1962) in Natural Resources Administration from the University of Maryland.
