## **SRBC TO MEET, PRESENT REPORTS ON FUTURE OF MARYLAND'S WATER AND HYDROLOGIC CONDITIONS, AND VOTE ON 25+ WATER WITHDRAWAL AND USE APPLICATIONS, FINAL REGULATION AMENDMENTS, UPDATES TO PROJECT FEES, COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

**WHAT:** The Susquehanna River Basin Commission (SRBC) will hold its regular quarterly business meeting, which is open to the public. SRBC will: review current hydrologic conditions throughout the Susquehanna River Basin; hear presentation on the future of Maryland's water and what actions are needed today; vote on the final revised Comprehensive Plan, final regulatory amendments affecting consumptive use requests for natural gas well development, recommended updates to project review fee schedule, resolution calling on the federal government to provide \$2.4 million for the Susquehanna flood forecast and warning system, and 25+ water withdrawal and consumptive use applications.
