UNITED STATES GYPSUM COMPANY WASHINGTONVILLE PLANT WITHDRAWAL AND CONSUMPTIVE USE OF WATER

The Susquehanna River Basin Commission (SRBC) will hold a public information meeting on Thursday, June 26, 2008, 6:30 p.m., at the Jane E. DeLong Memorial Hall (Community Center), 7 Church Street (corner of 3rd and Church Street), Washingtonville, Pennsylvania. The purpose of the meeting is to receive comments and answer questions on the United States Gypsum Company's application to withdraw 350,000 gallons per day (gpd) from groundwater and consumptively use up to 432,000 gpd, for processes related to the commercial production of gypsum wallboard.
