<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Groundwater remediation project withdrawing a consecutive 30-day average of 100,000 gallons per day (gpd) or more from a groundwater source or combination of sources.</li> <li>Consumptive use of water, of an average of 20,000 gpd or more in any consecutive 30-day period, from the groundwater remediation project. To qualify for this, the groundwater remediation project must be the sole water source for the consumptive use.</li> <li>Any groundwater remediation project withdrawal that is used as a source of water for a regulated consumptive use as described in Item 2 above.</li> </ol>			
<b>SECTION 4. WHERE GENERAL PERMIT DOES NOT APPLY</b>			
<b>Each General Permit (GP) has a specific set of restrictions and an answer of YES to any of the following would <u>PROHIBIT</u> the project from being eligible to register use of the GP:</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is the withdrawal from a surface water source only (e.g., not from a groundwater source)?</li> <li>Is the withdrawal to be used for quarry or mining activities for the primary purpose of dewatering mine workings?</li> <li>Is the withdrawal to be used for abandoned mine pump and treat projects?</li> <li>Is the withdrawal to be used for groundwater remediation projects that do not have state or federal environmental regulatory agency oversight?</li> <li>Is the withdrawal to be used for bulk supply water sales?</li> </ol>
