# GENERAL INFORMATION

The MWSA owns a public water system consisting of three wells, disinfection facilities, a finished water storage reservoir, and the distribution system. In the early 1900's, a surface water treatment plant on Black Hole Creek and a series of distribution lines throughout the Montgomery Borough were constructed. The treatment plant and distribution system served the borough and portion of Clinton Township until the early 1970's when MWSA undertook a major water system improvement project. As of now, MWSA has three wells servicing the entire system (Well #1, #3, and #4).

MWSA is requesting a maximum 30-day average of water withdrawal for Well #1 of 0.267 mgd. The current executive director is John Lynch.
