PROJECT FACILITY DESCRIPTION

Monroe Surface Water Withdrawal Chesapeake Appalachia, LLC

Chesapeake Appalachia, LLC (Chesapeake) is a natural gas exploration and development company requesting approval for a new surface water withdrawal (Monroe) of up to 1.5 million gallons per day (mgd) from Towanda Creek at a location off of Berwick Drive in Monroe Township, Bradford County, Pennsylvania. Chesapeake plans to initiate operation of the withdrawal in February 2021. Water will be used for activities related to natural gas exploration and production including well development, well drilling, well completion, and other site related activities on an as-needed basis. Water will be withdrawn via an over-the-bank system to an adjacent access pad. Water will be loaded onto trucks and transported to multiple nearby well pads. The Monroe water withdrawal also will be used to supplement development operations throughout Bradford and Sullivan Counties.
