# PROJECT FACILITY DESCRIPTION FARMERS PRIDE, INC. WATER SOURCE PRODUCTION WELL PW-4

#### 2.1 PROJECT FACILITY DESCRIPTION

The Project Facility for this water supply project is currently under construction on Chestnut Hill Road in Bethel Township, Lebanon County. The corporate name of the facility will be Bell & Evans Plant 3. The current and assumed long-term owner and operator of this proposed production well is Farmers Pride, Inc. (d/b/a Bell & Evans). The facility will be utilized as a chicken processing plant slated to start operations in October 2021. Currently, the facility under construction does not have a water supply. The facility will require approximately 1,400,000 gallons of water per day (gpd). As currently planned, this supply would be comprised of purchased water from the Fredericksburg Sewer and Water Authority (FSWA), the use of groundwater, and recycled water. It is anticipated that a water storage capacity of 300,000 gallons will also be implemented at the facility. Along with water extracted from proposed production wells PW-1, PW-2, and PW-3 (aquifer test plans previously submitted to SRBC), water extracted from proposed production well PW-4 will be conveyed to the Project Facility and treated wastewater from the Project Facility will be subsequently discharged to Little Swatara Creek through approximately 2.5 miles of piping installed in 2017. The piping traverses southeast through private property (Weaver Farm) and southerly along Union Road, terminating at the former Peters Tract immediately north of Little Swatara Creek.
