#### ATTACHMENT 3 – PROJECT FACILITY INFORMATION AND DESCRIPTION

Southwestern Energy Production Company, LLC (SWN) is a natural gas exploration company requesting approval of a surface water withdrawal of 3.000 million gallons per day (mgd) from Susquehanna River, located in Oakland Township, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania for use in hydrocarbon development. Water is proposed to be withdrawn through two submerged intake screens that will be placed in riverbed during pumping. A trailer mount pump will be used at this location to hook up to piping. The facility plans to begin operations in the Summer of 2022.

This facility will be used for hydrocarbon development and related incidental uses. The intent is to opportunistically provide pumping ability to a trailer mount pump and to local gas pad for drilling and extraction purposes from flow in Susquehanna River. Water is then transported via truck or overland quick line for consumptive use at SWN's approved natural gas well drilling pads.
