Application item 2.1 Project Facility Description

Bridgewater Golf Club is a 9-hole public golf course located at 601 Chestnut Hill Rd in York Pennsylvania. The purpose of the consumptive use and the quantities requested is to provide irrigation to the public golf course to include all fairways, greens, tee box areas, rough areas, practice putting areas and range area with a daily consumption up to a maximum of 100,000 gallons per day. The sources of this use are 2 ponds and a tributary to Mill Creek.

Site activities include a public golf course with 2 practice areas and a full driving range. Operation of the current nine-hole facility began in June of 2017. There is also a large maintenance building on the property, 3 fuel tanks, a large parking lot, access roads, and a public restaurant and pro shop which share a common building.

The nine-hole course has approximately 1 ½ acres of pond areas with both functional and ornamental components. The course sits on about 40 acres to include Tee boxes, greens, fairways, rough and environmentally sensitive areas.
