Facility Information

A water withdrawal is proposed within a meadow area with sparse trees owned by Franklin and Joan Rockefeller, and BKV Operating, LLC (BKV) has an executed option to lease the site. The site is located in Middletown Township, Susquehanna County, PA. The proposed withdrawal site includes a surface water withdrawal from North Branch Wyalusing Creek and a trailer housing the master meter and pump. North Branch Wyalusing Creek is designated as an attaining Cold-Water Fishery with migratory fish (CWF-MF) under PA Code 25 Chapter 93. The proposed withdrawal equipment includes a buried suction strainer, withdrawal pump, and master flow meter located in an above-ground trailer outside of the floodway.

Water from the withdrawal will be used for Hydrocarbon Development and Related Incidental Uses. The proposed monthly variable rated requested are show in Table 1 below. The anticipated start date for this operation is Spring, 2023 or shortly after the docket and associated permits for this site are approved.
