Liberty Forge Golf Course

Owner: Lucky Bear LLC , Operator: Hospitality Management Corp.

Liberty Forge is a 18 hole executive golf course which opened in 2003. It is a public golf course and practice facility. The course is a par 63, 3746 yard course, smaller than a typical sized course which is par 72, and 6500 yards long. This was part of the original design to minimize natural resource usage such as land and water. We have two functional ponds and 3 ornamental ponds on site.

Functional Ponds – 2.29 Acres

Ornamental Ponds – 2.05 Acres

To maintain the approximately 75 acres of bent grass turf, we use an irrigation system fed from our two functional ponds. These ponds are recharged with surface water from the Yellow Breeches Creek. Typical usage is approximately 9 to 13 million gal per year. Water is transferred as needed. We will irrigate throughout the summer months from April to October. Peak days could use in excess of 300k gal.

Liberty Forge has operated as a golf course and practice facility since 2003.

We do not propose to change the existing permit, as it has sufficed for our purposes.
